

SAGIT Governance Policy 15 – Privacy

This Privacy Policy sets out the commitment of SA Grain Industry Trust, its successors and assignees (referred to as **we**, **us** and **our**) to protecting the privacy of your personal information in accordance with the *Privacy Act 1988* (Cth) (**Privacy Act**) and the Australian Privacy Principles (**APPs**). This Privacy Policy sets out the personal information we collect through this website www.*sagit*.com.au (**Site**) or directly from you, being the person, organisation or entity that uses our Site or services (referred to as **you** or **your**).

Please read this Privacy Policy carefully. Please contact us if you have any questions – our contact details are at the end of this Privacy Policy.

You are providing us with personal information indicates that you have had sufficient opportunity to access this Privacy Policy and that you have read and accepted it.

Solicited Information

The main types of personal information we collect, and hold relate to:

- applications for SAGIT investment for the purposes of a particular Research and Development project
- individuals participating in projects and initiatives we invest in
- our Board members or individuals attending meetings or consulting with us
- procurement and contract management
- performance of our legislative functions
- conflict of interest declarations
- contact and mailing lists
- requests for publications
- media content and any other information requested on this Site or otherwise requested by us or provided by you.

Your use of our Site: As with most online businesses, we may log information about your access and use of our Site, including using Internet cookies, your communications with our Site, the type of browser you are using, the type of operating system you are using and the domain name of your Internet service provider.

If we receive your personal information from third parties, we will protect it as set out in this Privacy Policy.

Collection and use of personal information

We collect and use the information for purposes including:

- to provide our services as set out on the Site or otherwise notified to you.
- to contact and communicate with you.
- for market research and business development including website development.
- for data analytics purposes.

Disclosure of personal information to third parties

We may disclose personal information to

 courts, tribunals, regulatory authorities, and law enforcement officers as required by law, in connection with any actual or prospective legal proceedings, or in order to establish, exercise or defend our legal rights.

Sensitive information will be used and disclosed for purposes relating to the primary purpose for which sensitive information was collected, including,

providing the relevant services in accordance with your request

Sensitive information may also be used or disclosed if:

- required or authorised by law; or
- to a responsible person which has the meaning given by section 6AA of the Privacy Act 1988.

Your rights and controlling your personal information.

Choice and consent: When you provide us with your personal information, you consent to the terms in this Privacy Policy, and to us disclosing or receiving your personal information for these purposes.

Your provision of third-party information: If you provide us with third party personal information then you warrant to us that you have the third party's consent to provide this.

Restrict: You may choose to restrict the collection or use of your personal information. If you have previously agreed to us using your personal information you may change your mind at any time by contacting us at the email address listed in this Privacy Policy.

Access: You may request details of personal information that we hold about you, in certain circumstances set out in the Privacy Act. We may refuse to provide you with information that we hold about you, in certain circumstances set out in the Privacy Act.

Correction: If you believe that any information, we hold about you is inaccurate, out of date, incomplete, irrelevant, or misleading, please contact us by email. We rely in part upon customers advising us when their personal information changes. We will respond to any request within a reasonable time. We will endeavour to promptly correct any information found to be inaccurate, incomplete, or out of date.

Complaints: If you believe that we have breached the Privacy Act or APPs and wish to make a complaint about that breach, please contact us by email setting out details of the breach. We will promptly investigate your complaint and respond to you in writing setting out the outcome of our investigation, what steps we propose to take to remedy the breach and any other action we will take to deal with your complaint.
